Follow up Questions and ADOT Responses

- 1. Will I-10 be reduced to one lane in each direction during the construction of the new interchanges at Miller and Watson roads?**
 - a. Yes, but these restrictions will only occur between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. during the week, and 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. on weekends.

- 2. Is it possible to slow traffic on SR 85 and Broadway since this is being used as part of the detour route?**
 - a. ADOT is able to slow traffic at this intersection and can place DPS officers at the intersection.

- 3. Where will the VMS signs be placed? How far out are they providing notice for the detours?**
 - a. This information will be available once the contractor is ready to start the reconstruction of the interchanges.
 - b. In addition, the city of Buckeye will add additional VMS signs along I-10 and SR 85 to notify drivers as early as possible about the detours.

- 4. Where can we review the funding allocation for this project?**
 - a. The Maricopa Association of Governments is the designated metropolitan planning organization (MPO) for transportation planning in the greater Phoenix metropolitan region. Funding information is also provided in the Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) which can be viewed online - <https://www.azmag.gov/Programs/Transportation/Regional-Transportation-Plan-RTP>
 - b. In addition, ADOT has a Five-Year Transportation Construction Program that highlights the planned project currently being designed or constructed. It also included funding sources for each project. <https://azdot.gov/planning/transportation-programming/current-five-year-program>

- 5. What is being done about the interchange at Jackrabbit? This intersection will get even more congested and dangerous with detour traffic.**
 - a. ADOT will work with MCDOT and the city of Buckeye to monitor this area and evaluate the best option to help alleviate congestion in this area.

- 6. Will there be any restrictions or closures during Super Bowl weekend?**
 - a. No freeway closures will be scheduled during the Super Bowl, major holiday and other events, like the Buckeye Air Fair.
